

Russia and Iberoamerica in the Global World

Fourth International Forum (1 – 3 October 2019)

On October 1-3, 2019, St. Petersburg State University in coordination with Institute of Latin America of RAS, Institute of Bering-Bellingshausen for Americas, Foundation of Egor Gaidar, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Russian Federation and Bank Santander, CRIES (The Regional Coordinator of Economic and Social Research), CLACSO (Latin American Council for Social Sciences), AMECIP (Mexican Association of Political Sciences) will hold the fourth international forum "Russia and Iberoamerica in the globalizing world: history and modernity". The forum is the most representative event in Russia devoted to socio-political, economic processes of Latin America, its history and culture. Carried out in St. Petersburg and marked by participation of famous politicians, scientists, journalists of the Ibero-American countries and Russia, the Forum steadily draws attention of media that confirms the status of the St. Petersburg university as one of the leading centers of iberoamerican studies in Russia.

The IV International Forum "Russia and Iberoamerica in the globalizing world: history and modernity" continues the tradition of conferences and forums dedicated to Latin American studies, organized by Saint Petersburg State University, the Institute of Latin America, the Bering-Bellingshausen Institute for the Americas with the support of Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Russian Federation, the Government of St. Petersburg in 2003, 2013, 2015 and 2017, and it will be mainly devoted to the mechanisms of the formation of a multipolar world.

An important part of the Forum's agenda is regional political and economic integration (analysis of the Pacific and Atlantic integration vectors), as well as the role of China, the US, EU and Russia in the economic processes of Latin America.

In the field of political studies the Forum will be devoted to the analysis of political systems evolution of Latin America, political party development, phenomenon of left and right turns both on the national level and within the regional framework.

Latin America is one of the most dynamically developing regions of the world. The political and social-economic phenomena of the continent influence global processes and formation of the multipolar world in many ways.

The Latin American vector becomes key in foreign policy of many states and new centers of power. Latin America itself becomes a link between Europe, Asia and Africa. It makes critical reconsideration of history of the region utterly necessary, including revolutionary processes of the XX century, Cold War and modern political process.
